Subject	What we will be learning about
<b>Personal, social and emotional development</b>	<p>Our learning this half term will focus on getting the children settled within their new environment.</p> <p>We will be doing lots of work developing social skills to help them build friendships with other children within the class.</p> <p>Welcome to our new children - we will be doing lots of work to ensure that all children develop a bond with the adults in reception as this helps greatly with their transition and will make entering the classroom without parents far easier.</p>
<b>Structured story time</b>	<p>Our structured story time texts are; What Makes Me? My Family &amp; Other Families, My Hair, Luna Loves Art and Pumpkin Soup</p>
<b>English</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● We will be encouraging lots of mark making, working on strengthening their hands and developing a more secure pencil grip.</li> <li>● Initial sounds and cvc word reading</li> <li>● Name writing</li> <li>● RWI groups will be established</li> </ul>
<b>Maths</b>	<p><b><u>Number</u></b> Egg Box Maths to 5, Representing numbers to 5, one more/ one less,</p> <p>Explore numbers within 10: to find one more and one less, one-to-one correspondence, explore subitizing</p> <p><b><u>Numerical patterns</u></b> Counting songs</p> <p>Colour and size patterns</p> <p><b>Please send in egg boxes of 10</b></p>
<b>Communication and language</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Extending our sentences</li> <li>● Building confidence to ask for help and express own needs</li> <li>● Extending our joint attention</li> </ul>
<b>Expressive arts and design</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Exploring colour independently</li> <li>● Colour mixing (adult led)</li> <li>● Using one handed tools</li> <li>● Exploring role-play themes with a small group</li> </ul>

<b>Understanding the world</b>	<b>Geography</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Exploring the jobs that happen in our community</li> <li>● Autumn walk to collect treasures (Map work to explore area prior to visit)</li> <li>● Map drawing using photos from Autumn walk</li> </ul> <b>Science</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Seasonal changes - learn about signs of Autumn</li> <li>● Pumpkin soup - observing changes that occur in everyday materials</li> </ul>
<b>Physical development</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● PE is on Tuesday - please send your child into school in P.E kit</li> <li>● We will be encouraging independence by developing their self-care skills in activities such as going to the toilet, washing hands, eating at lunch-time and putting on/ taking off coats.</li> </ul>
