Writing	<ul> <li>Plan by talking about ideas and writing notes.</li> <li>Use well-chosen adjectives to add detail.</li> <li>Sequence sentences to form clear narratives.</li> <li>Re-read writing to check it makes sense.</li> </ul>
Reading	<ul> <li>Read common exception words, noting unusual correspondences between spelling and sound and where these occur in the word.</li> <li>Link reading to your own experiences and other books.</li> <li>Explain and discuss understanding of texts.</li> </ul>
Maths	Our units in maths are: • Positions • Number to 20 • Addition and Subtraction within 20
Art	<ul> <li>Respond to ideas and starting points.</li> <li>Use thick and thin brushes.</li> <li>Describe the work of notable artists, artisans and designers.</li> </ul>
Science	<ul> <li>Introduce plants <ul> <li>Animals including humans</li> <li>Identify and name a variety of common plants, including garden plants, wild plants and trees and those classified as deciduous and evergreen.</li> <li>identify and name a variety of common animals including fish, amphibians, reptiles, birds and mammals</li> <li>identify and name a variety of common animals that are carnivores, herbivores and omnivores</li> <li>describe and compare the structure of a variety of common animals (fish, amphibians, reptiles, birds and mammals including pets)</li> <li>identify, name, draw and label the basic parts of the human body and say which part of the body is associated with each sense</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
Music	<ul> <li>Clap rhythms.</li> <li>Create a mixture of different sounds (long and short, loud and quiet, high and low).</li> <li>Create short, rhythmic phrases.</li> </ul>

PE	<ul> <li>Our PE day is Wednesday afternoon.</li> <li>Please ensure your child comes to school wearing their PE clothes and that they are suitable for the weather.</li> </ul>
RE	<ul> <li>How do we celebrate special &amp; sacred times? Christmas</li> <li>Identify the things that are important in their own lives and compare these to religious beliefs.</li> <li>Describe some of the main festivals or celebrations of a religion.</li> <li>Recognise, name and describe some religious artefacts, places and practices.</li> </ul>
Geography	<ul> <li>Continents, oceans and countries of the UK</li> <li>Use world maps, atlases and globes to identify the United Kingdom and its countries, as well as the countries, continents and oceans studied.</li> <li>Name and locate the world's continents and oceans.</li> </ul>
History	<ul> <li>Changes within living memory</li> <li>Ask questions such as: What was it like for people? What happened? How long ago?</li> <li>Recognise that there are reasons why people in the past acted as they did.</li> <li>Place events and artefacts in order on a time line.</li> </ul>
PSHE	<ul> <li>Celebrating Differences</li> <li>We will be considering how we are similar and different from others in our class.</li> <li>This will develop into looking at how we are all unique and celebrating our differences.</li> </ul>
Computing	<ul> <li>We will use the programme <b>Purple Mash</b> to develop our ICT skills.</li> <li>Our focus will be on coding and spreadsheets.</li> </ul>
