Christmas Activities

Christmas is a very special and exciting time of the year in a primary school and as always, we will endeavour to make it a special time for all of our children here at Wardley.

Class Christmas Shows – In the week beginning Monday 09.12.24. Dates on the autumn term date list. The classes are all going to be putting on their own special Christmas Shows for parents and carers to come and see. The children will be singing Christmas songs, reciting Christmas poems and sharing their Christmas thoughts. We really enjoyed the opportunity to do this in school last year and are very excited about giving you the chance to come into school again and share this special event with the children this year. The morning show will start at 9.00am and the afternoon services will start at 2.40pm. There will be two tickets per child for each of the performances. The children should come to school on the day of their Christmas show in festive Christmas party clothes – such as Christmas jumpers, sparkles or Christmas colours. Christmas Jumper Day – Friday 13.12.24.

This is a non-uniform fundraising day for the Save The Children charity. If they want to, the children can come to school dressed in a Christmas jumper/festive party clothing. Each class will have time in the hall to play party games and then do Christmas activities in class and watch a Christmas film with some party food.
