In the Y2 classroom this week In Maths, this term, we have been doing multiplication and the children have relished learning their 2's. 5's and 10's. In English we have been reading a beautiful book called The Christmas Pine, all about the Norwegian tree that is sent to Trafalgar Square, in London, each Christmas, which the children loved. We enjoyed looking on Google Earth at Trafalgar Square and Nelson's Column because we have been using Google Earth in our geography lessons to find out about other landmarks in London such as, the Shard, London Bridge and Big Ben. This is part of our studies where we are comparing London with the city of Nairobi in Kenya. We also found Pudding Lane and the Monument in London, using Google Earth, continuing our investigations into the Great Fire of London. In DT we are sewing and looking at patchworks, which the children are thoroughly enjoying too.
