Curriculum Leaflet
Autumn Term Two

Subject	What we will be learning about
<p style="text-align: center;">English</p>	<p>The children will be continuing their Read Write Inc. reading journeys this half-term. We will be learning the following sounds: d, t, i, n, p and g whilst reviewing the sounds learnt last half-term, m, a and s.</p> <p>Our core texts to be read during our Structured Storytime sessions will be:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - 'Wow' Said the Owl - The Dot - Come Over to My House - Ravi's Roar - The Snowy Day <p>These stories will allow us to explore new vocabulary and different themes throughout the half-term.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Maths</p>	<p>In maths, the children will have lots of counting practice, making sure that their numbers are in the correct order. They will be learning to recognise numerals, initially 0 to 5, and matching quantities to these numerals.</p> <p>The children will also be introduced to the concept of measuring length and will be using words such as <i>longer and shorter</i>.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Communication and language</p>	<p>Children will be developing their listening and attention skills through listening games, stories and circle time.</p> <p>The children will be immersed in lots of new vocabulary around the topics of Autumn and Celebrations.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Expressive arts and design</p>	<p>The children will be exploring colour and colour mixing this half term. When Christmas gets a little closer, they will have the opportunity to create lots of Christmas crafts. They will also be learning Christmas songs in preparation for their Christmas performance in December.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Understanding the world</p>	<p>The children will be learning about different celebrations including Christmas and Diwali. They will also be exploring all things <i>Autumn</i>. They will be noticing the changes we see during Autumn and exploring natural objects that can be found during Autumn.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Physical development</p>	<p>There will be lots of activities out in the classroom provision aimed at developing children's fine motor skills such as threading, weaving and colouring,</p> <p>In the outdoor provision, children will be encouraged to get out of breath through physical activity every day. We will be encouraging children to practise moving in different ways such as running, hopping, jumping and skipping.</p>

We will also be learning about the meaning of Christmas later in the term.
