


Subject	We will be learning about
<p>Writing</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • We will write first- person narrative and instructional texts. • Writing in sentences using handwriting, capital letters and full stops. • Practising other devices like adverbs, adjectives and direct speech. • A special morning focus on spelling and handwriting. • Three one-hour lessons designated to writing skills. • Top Tip – Complete the spelling sheets for Friday
<p>Reading</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Our core text is Operation Gadgetman by Malorie Blackman. • The children will continue with 'Boom Reader' at home and in school. Well done to all those children who read regularly at home. • We will begin to use Reading Plus in the classroom too. • The core book will fuel our reading comprehension too. • Top Tip – Complete Boom Reader for rewards aplenty.
<p>Maths</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • This term's Maths' lessons will continue to be taught through Maths No Problem (MNP) as well as our own initiatives. • Each day will start with 5-a-day and extra challenges. • Our topics will be Volume and Money. • Children will be given extra support whenever they need it • Top Tip – Practise 3 x, 4 x and 8 x tables every night.
<p>Art and Design</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Our Art and Design will focus on 'Collage'. • We will create fantastic pieces with line, colour and texture. • The children develop new ideas using pens, fabrics and dyes. • Vocabulary will include mandala, radial and symbol. • Top Tip – Create your own collage with spare materials at home.
<p>Science</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Our Science topic is all about Plant Growth. • We will ask ourselves a question at the start of each lesson. • What are the parts of a plant and what are their functions? • What do plants need to live and grow? • How do leaves, flowers, stem and roots do for the plant? • Vocabulary will include photosynthesis, germination and pollination. • Top Tip – Check out this half-term's project all about plant growth.
<p>Music</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The History of singing • We will rehearse, perform and evaluate our singing. • Singing gospel songs, folk songs, war songs and sea shanties. • Vocabulary will include pitch, structure, choir, medley and orchestra • Top Tip – Look up and sing some sea shanties at home.

PE 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • P.E. lessons will take place on Thursday afternoons. • Please ensure that you child has the correct kit for both indoor and outdoor use as weather permitting • Top Tip - Play some games, ride your bike, tidy your room...
RE 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • In RE, the children will learn about 'How, Why and Where People Pray'. • How and why prayer is so important to different faiths. • Finding differences and similarities between praying within different religions like Islam and Hinduism. • Top Tip – Research to find out about Hinduism, Judaism and Isalm.
PSHE 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • In PSHE our topic is 'Healthy Me'. • Benefits of keeping fit and healthy. • Learn how exercise affects parts of our bodies like heart and lungs. • We will also be learning a little about drugs and medicines and other substances that may be harmful if not used correctly. • Top Tip – Think about your diet, exercise and hygiene at home.

Reading	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Reading at least 4 times per week • Check for fluency, accuracy and expression. • Completing Boom Reader after reading pages • Remember to select the 'completed book' option • Make sure that I change my book in the class library
Homework Project	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Check the homework project its deadline. • Make sure that I start my research for the project in plenty of time. • Make sure that I bring my project into school by the deadline.
